Minutes of the 34th Stated Meeting
February 7 & 8, 2020

- 34-01** POA met for its 34th Stated Meeting, hosted by Mill Creek Presbyterian Church in Hookstown, PA. Notice to the POA churches was given at least 30 days prior to the meeting.
- 34-02** The business meeting began 4:15 pm on February 7, 2020 in the Sanctuary of Mill Creek Presbyterian Church, Hookstown, PA, following a time of worship.
- 34-03 Call to Order:** Moderator TE Josh Brown from Bellefield EPC called the meeting to order and opened the meeting with prayer.
- 34-04 Welcome** by RE Rebecca Beckert from Mill Creek EPC. She gave a history of the church, dating from 1785, it was part of the first Presbytery west of the Allegheny Mountains. She provided an overview of the local missions supported.
- 34-05 Quorum:** With concurrence of the Stated Clerk, RE Ray Kinat, Moderator Brown declared a quorum.
- 34-06 Attendance of TE's and RE Commissioners:** There were 44 Teaching Elders (TEs) and 54 Ruling Elder Commissioners (REs) present (excluding transitional members), according to the sign-in sheets. 34-08 Moderator Brown explained the voting procedures for this 34nd Stated Meeting (using written ballots to vote for ministers being examined, descending overtures from General Assembly, and ascending overtures, verbal ballots for candidates) and reminded everyone that only TE's and RE Commissioners can vote. Moderator Brown then reminded all TEs and RE Commissioners that they should have a packet that contains all of the written reports and forms that would be discussed at this meeting.

34-09 Moderator Brown then welcomed all those in attendance and asked first-time attendees to introduce themselves.

34-10 Moderator Brown invited Stated Clerk Ray Kinat forward. RE Kinat made a motion from the Leadership Team to elect TE Dana Opp as the new Stated Clerk, to assume the duties beginning September 2020. Motion Carried.

34-11 Report of Ministerial Committee: Moderator Brown then invited TE Eric Toohey forward to give the report of the Ministerial Committee (written report included in the Commissioners' Packet). TE Toohey opened the report with prayer.

34-11A TE Toohey explained the role of the Ministerial Committee and provided an overview of their activities. He referred to the written report in the packet. He announced that next year's Pastors' Retreat will be Jan 31-Feb 2, 2021. TE Toohey announced that the MC will be calling all TE this year to fill in their annual report and to provide a pastoral checkup and pray for them.

34-11B TE Toohey then indicated there were items that needed presbytery approval:
Omnibus Motion of the Ministerial Committee:

- Renew the call for Commissioned Pastor Glenn Meyers at Ardara United Presbyterian Church (Ardara, PA) for three more years.
- Move the following active teaching elders to associate status:

- Approve TE Robert Cummings to serve out of bounds as the Transitional Pastor for Oreland Evangelical Presbyterian Church (Oreland, PA). Oreland EPC is in the geographic bounds of the Presbytery of the East.
- Renew the following Out of Bounds calls for another year:
 - Robert Cappel – Treasure Lake Church (Dubois, PA)
 - Jarrod Crawford – St. John's Reformed Church (Butler, PA)

 - Scott Steltzer – Summer's Best Two Weeks
- Approve the following dissolutions where the pastor and congregation concur:
 - Mt. Perry Evangelical Presbyterian Church of Mt. Perry, Ohio in a duly called congregational meeting on November 10, 2019 voted to dissolve the call of TE Bryan Bushong. TE Bushong is without call.
 - Hudson Evangelical Presbyterian Church of Hudson, Ohio in a duly called congregational meeting on December 22, 2019 voted to dissolve the call of TE Rob Sparr. TE Sparr is without call.
 - Graystone Evangelical Presbyterian Church of Indiana, PA in a duly called congregational meeting on January 12, 2020 voted to dissolve the call of TE Ryan Mowen. TE Mowen has taken another call.
- Dismiss TE Ryan Mowen to accept the call of Pastor at Church of the Atonement (Silver Spring, MD) in the Northeast Presbytery of the Associate Reformed Presbyterian Church.

Omnibus motion approved

34-11C TE Toohey invited forward to be examined Dan Clark for transfer into the EPC from the Mid America Presbytery EPC and Jim Moelk for transfer into the POA from Lake Erie Presbytery (PCUSA).

- The Ministerial Committee recommends TE Dan Clark , a member of the Mid-America Presbytery of the EPC. In accordance with **BOG 10-8 C** and **BOG 10-7 C.2**. TE Clark is seeking transfer from the Presbytery of the Mid-America to accept a call of Pastor of Hickory United Presbyterian Church (Hickory, PA). In accordance with the **BOG12-4**, TE Clark reported his exception(s) to the Westminster Confession and Catechisms. WCF: 21.8 were declared to the Presbytery. ON MOTION Presbytery acted to allow the exception(s). In accordance with the **BOG 12-3A** TE Clark was examined. On motion, the examination was arrested and TE Clark was excused. ON MOTION, the minister's examination was sustained in the areas prescribed by **BOG 12-3B.1**. TE Clark was welcomed into the Presbytery.
- The Ministerial Committee recommends Rev. Moelk, a retired, ordained minister of the PCUSA, seeking transfer from the Lake Erie Presbytery (PCUSA) in order to become an Associate Member of the Presbytery of the Alleghenies. Having sustained oral examination before the Ministerial Committee, Rev. Moelk was presented to the Presbytery for examination. In accordance with the **BOG 12-4**, Rev. Moelk's exception(s) to the Westminster Confession of Faith and Catechisms WCF: 21.8 were declared to the Presbytery In accordance with the **BOG 12-4**. ON MOTION, Rev. Moelk's exception(s) to the Westminster Confession of Faith and Catechisms were allowed. The Presbytery then examined Rev. Moelk on his views in accordance with the **BOG 12-2**. On motion, the examination was arrested and Rev. Moelk was excused. ON MOTION, the minister's examination was sustained in the areas prescribed by **BOG 12-3B.1**. Rev. Moelk was welcomed into the Presbytery.

TE Douglas Kortyna prayed over TE Clark and TE Moelk

- The Ministerial Committee recommends RE Caleb Musselman to be examined by the presbytery as a Commissioned Pastor of SOMA (Beaver Falls, PA) with the authorization to preach the Word, evangelize, moderate the Session, administer the sacraments, perform marriages, preside at funerals, and provide pastoral care. This term will be for three years and is renewable. In accordance with **BOG 9-11**, RE Mussleman was examined and found to have sufficient knowledge in the areas in which he will be serving. RE Mussleman declared exception(s) to the Westminster Confession of Faith and Catechisms WCF: 21.8 were declared to the Presbytery. ON MOTION, RE Mussleman exception(s) to the Westminster Confession of Faith and Catechisms were allowed. On motion, the examination was arrested and RE Musselman was excused. ON MOTION, the Commissioned Pastor's examination was sustained in the areas prescribed by **BOG 9-11B**. Commissioned Pastor RE Caleb

Musselman was welcomed into the Presbytery. The Ministerial Committee recommends TE Josh Brown as Caleb's supervisor and mentor, per **BOG 9-11D**. The MC Committee, serving as a POA Administrative Commission will administer the vows of commissioning per **BOG 9-11F**. RE Mussleman will serve as Commissioned Pastor for a period of 3 years, per **BOG 9-11A**, at The SOMA Gathering (POA church), Beaver Falls. TE Marc De Jue, First Presbyterian Beaver Falls, prayed over RE Caleb Musselman.

34-11D TE Toohey indicated that this concluded the Ministerial Committee report for the evening and that the report would continue in the morning.

34-12 Moderator Joshua Brown invited Jen Burkholder forward to give a report on the EPC Next Gen Council of which she is Chair and Ministry Adviser Partner. The Council strives to serve, to equip, resource and encourage the college, children and youth workers in the church. GA approved a goal of creating networking opportunities for those working in those areas. Jen asks for the support of the Presbytery while they develop the local network. There will be a networking meeting at the May 2020 Stated Meeting.

Break for Dinner at 6 PM and worship at 7:30PM.

34-13 The 34nd Stated Meeting of the Presbytery of the Alleghenies reconvened at 9 am on February 8 following a time of worship at 8:30 am. Moderator TE Brown opened with prayer and gave a recap of last evening's activities. First time visitors were introduced.

Announcement TE Josh Brown read a report from RE Brian Altmyer from the GA Nominating Committee looking for TE and RE to serve on National Committees. Additional information will be mailed to the Pastors in the following week.

34-14 Continuation of the Ministerial Committee Report: Moderator Brown called forward TE Eric Toohey to continue the report of the Ministerial Committee. TE Toohey opened with prayer. We recommend Justin Olivetti to be examined on doctrine by the presbytery as a minister seeking to transfer from the National Association of Christian Congregational Churches to accept a call as Pastor of Knox Presbyterian Church (Kenmore, NY). Mr. Olivetti has been serving Knox as a Stated Supply. In accordance with **BOG 12-3.B.2** transferring from a non-reformed body Mr. Olivetti was examined as a Candidate. Mr. Olivetti, having completed the candidacy requirements prescribed in **BOG.11-2** and having sustained written examinations and then oral examination before the Ministerial Committee, was presented to the Presbytery for examination for the office of Teaching Elder. Mr. Olivetti's exception(s) to the Westminster Confession of Faith and Catechisms were declared to the Presbytery In accordance with the **BOG 12-4**. ON MOTION, Mr. Olivetti's exception(s) to the Westminster Confession of Faith and Catechisms were allowed. The Presbytery then examined Mr. Olivetti in accordance with **BOG 12-2**. On motion, the examination was arrested and Mr. Olivetti was excused. MOTION CARRIED and a vote was taken and Mr. Olivetti was found to be acceptable. Mr. Olivetti was welcomed into the Presbytery. Mr. Olivetti signed the Ministerial Obligation Form, which is on file in the Clerk's office.

In accordance with **BOG 13-1A**, members of the Ministerial Committee serve as Administrative Commission for the POA to review the terms of call for ministers. As such, TE Toohey indicated that the terms of call for TE Clark called to serve as Pastor of Hickory Church EPC and Mr. Olivetti called to serve as Pastor of Knox EPC were found to be in order according to the BOO. The Ministerial Committee, appointed by the presbytery as an administrative commission to install and ordain pastors, will do so for TE Clark and Mr. Olivetti and the Minutes of same will be on file.

34-14A TE Toohey indicated this concluded the report from the Ministerial Committee

34-15 Commissioned Pastor Report Moderator Brown invited RE Glenn Meyers forward to give a report on his ministry at Ardara United Presbyterian Church (Ardara, PA) He indicated his strong sense of call to Ardara and the ministry there. Glenn is excited about the growth of the church and the offerings of gifts to the ministry of the church and community. Glenn feels privileged and grateful to have the support of his congregation to serve as the Moderator of the General Assembly. He thanked the Presbytery for extending his call and asked for the prayers as he moves into the Moderator of the General Assembly. Moderator Brown led the Presbytery in prayer for RE Meyers.

34-16 Report of the Church Development Committee (CDC): Moderator Brown called forward TE Chris Mathewson to give his report. TE Mathewson opened with prayer. TE Mathewson referred to the written report in the packet. TE Mathewson summarized the work of the various teams within the CDC: Inquiring Church Team; Transitional Pastor Team; Elder Training Team; Vitality/Coaching Team; Church Planting Team.

34-16A MOTION: The CDC Moves that in accordance with BOO 5.6 the POA receive Natrona Heights Presbyterian and Calvin Presbyterian as full members of the POA having met and fulfilled the requirements with members of the CDC acting as an appointed commission of the Presbytery. Motion Carried. TE Lindon Fowler prayed over the new churches.

34-16B TE Mathewson invited TE Rick Stauffer and RE members of Covenant Sharon to describe their experience of working with the Vitality/Coaching Team. The Vitality process impacted the infrastructure of the church, looking outside their doors for ministry challenged them to identify who they are.

34-16C CDC Manual: Over the last year the CDC has re worked our manual. It is our intent that the manual serves two primary purposes: To be a procedure source for key moments in the church life such as transition time and to be a resource for those churches needing guide to the Vitality process.

34-16D TE Mathewson indicated that this concluded his report.

Announcements

- TE Chris White was invited forward to promote the 2nd Annual Golf Outing on June 6, 2020 to benefit our mission partner EduNations. He encouraged churches to participate by providing donations for auction and sponsoring golf foursomes.

- RE Bruce Tenenbaum spoke to a mission trip that he and TE Scot Graham are making to Sierra Leone. They will be visiting the churches and encouraging the pastors of Sierra Leone. They will be doing some Elder training. He requested the prayers for him and Scott over their trip. A letter will be going out the following week seeking financial support for the Elder Celebrations in the villages. Moderator Brown over the trip.
- TE Doug Kortyna spoke to the fraternal relationship with the Mexican Presbyterian Church. He spoke of Redeemer's recent mission trip to Monteray. TE Kortyna issued a challenge to churches to join them on a mission trip in 2021.
- TE Harper Brady invited Teaching Elders of the Presbytery to go on a Wilderness Canoe Trip in September 2020.

34-17 Report of the Business Committee: Moderator Brown called forward RE Ray Kinat, Temporary Chair, to give the report. RE Kinat opened with prayer.

34-18 Report of the Leadership Team and Stated Clerk: Moderator Brown then invited RE Ray Kinat forward to present the report of the Leadership Team and Stated Clerk (written report included in the Commissioner's Packet). RE Kinat opened his report with prayer.

34-18A RE Kinat indicated that there were several actions that needed presbytery approval:

34-18B RE Kinat reviewed Descending Overtures from GA. In accordance with **BOG 19-4 C.3**. Stated Clerk Kinat called for a paper ballot vote on the Descending Overtures from the 39th GA Stated Meeting. A vote was taken and the results were announced. Vote Results; Overture 19-A Yes 61 No 2 ; Overture 19-B Yes 62 No 2. The results of the vote will be communicated to the EPC Office of the General Assembly.

Announcement TE Rodger Woodworth published a book called 'Kingdom Holiness' which is recommended for members of the Presbytery

34-18C RE Kinat reviewed the Annual Disparity Report (included in the packet). He announced a training session for Clerks of Session at the May Stated Meeting

34-18D RE Kinat noted that he had received: Minutes of Commission to Install – Scott Steltzer at St. Paul’s and Eric Phillips at Mt. Carmel. Everything is in order.

34-18E 35th Stated Meeting will be held May 1&2, 2020 at Hickory EPC and the 36th Stated Meeting

34-18F RE Kinat indicated that this concluded his report.
